



# Olympic Solidarity 2021-2024 Plan Team Support Grant (TSG) Tokyo Extension Principles Guidelines

**The Guidelines for this programme remain applicable, and the extension will be applied according to the following principles.**

All National Olympic Committees (NOCs) with a team that is already benefiting from the TSG programme and has qualified for the Olympic Games Tokyo 2020, or is participating in the final qualification rounds, may apply for an additional Tokyo extension grant of a maximum of USD 25,000 per NOC, with the following conditions:

- This additional grant is available from 2021 in principle, but NOCs wishing to apply in 2020 should contact the OS Athletes Unit.
- Activities with budgets already allocated within the framework of the TSG programme but not yet organised due to the current circumstances may be rescheduled until later this year, but the reporting must be completed by 30 November 2020 at the latest.
- No advance payments will be made in 2020. Therefore, full payment of the allocated budgets and/or the Tokyo extension grant will be made once reporting is complete. If the reports are received after 30 November 2020, the budgets will be forfeited.

NOCs that have not previously applied for funding within the framework of the TSG programme but have a team that has qualified for the Olympic Games Tokyo 2020 may also apply for the Tokyo extension budget. In this case, the above conditions will also apply.

- Team Support Grant 2017-2020 files must be closed by 30 November 2020 on the OS Online Platform.
- This programme will be relaunched as part of the new Olympic Solidarity 2021-2024 plan and, from 2021, NOCs will be able to apply for funding directly on RELAY, including the additional Tokyo extension budget.
